The objective of the Industrial Disaster Management Plan is to make use of the combined resources of the plant and the outside services to achieve the following:


- Effect the rescue and medical treatment of casualties;
- Safeguard other people;
- Minimize damage to property and the environment;
- Initially contain and ultimately bring the incident under control;
- Identify any dead;
- Provide for the needs of relatives;
- Provide authoritative information to the news media;
- Secure the safe rehabilitation of affected area;
- Preserve relevant records and equipment for the subsequent inquiry into the cause and circumstances of the emergency.

In effect, it is to optimize operational efficiency to rescue rehabilitation and render medical help and to restore normalcy. Disaster Management Plan should include Emergency Preparedness Plan, Emergency Response Team, Emergency Communication, Emergency Responsibilities, Emergency Facilities, and Emergency Actions.

The principal of the college, S.S.Tawade in his presidential address said, "Compared to other gases LPG has clean and smoke-free ignition. It does not produce toxic gas and has clean burning. In disaster-stricken areas, where the air quality is already compromised, using LPG helps in minimising further pollution to maintain a healthy work environment for survivors, rescue and relief workers.." why LPG Workshop under Disaster Management program was hosted by Prof. D.S. 



