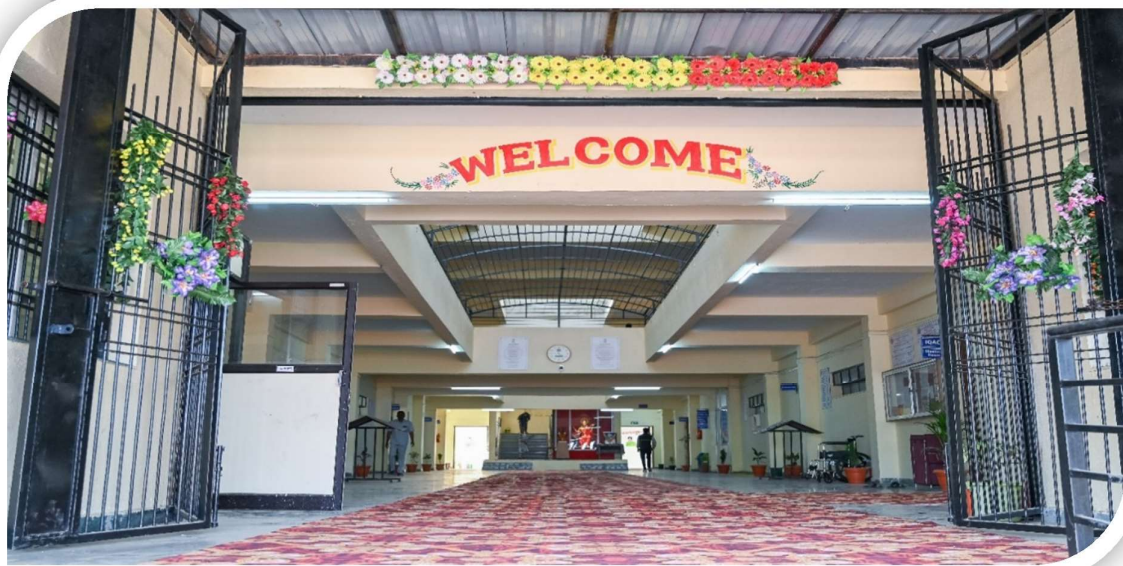

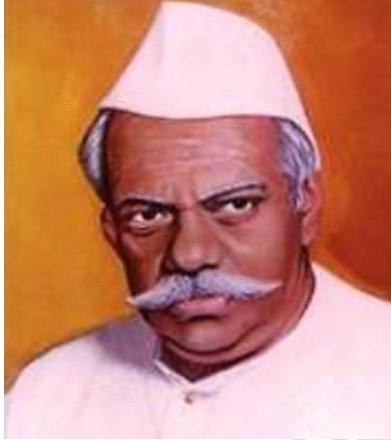

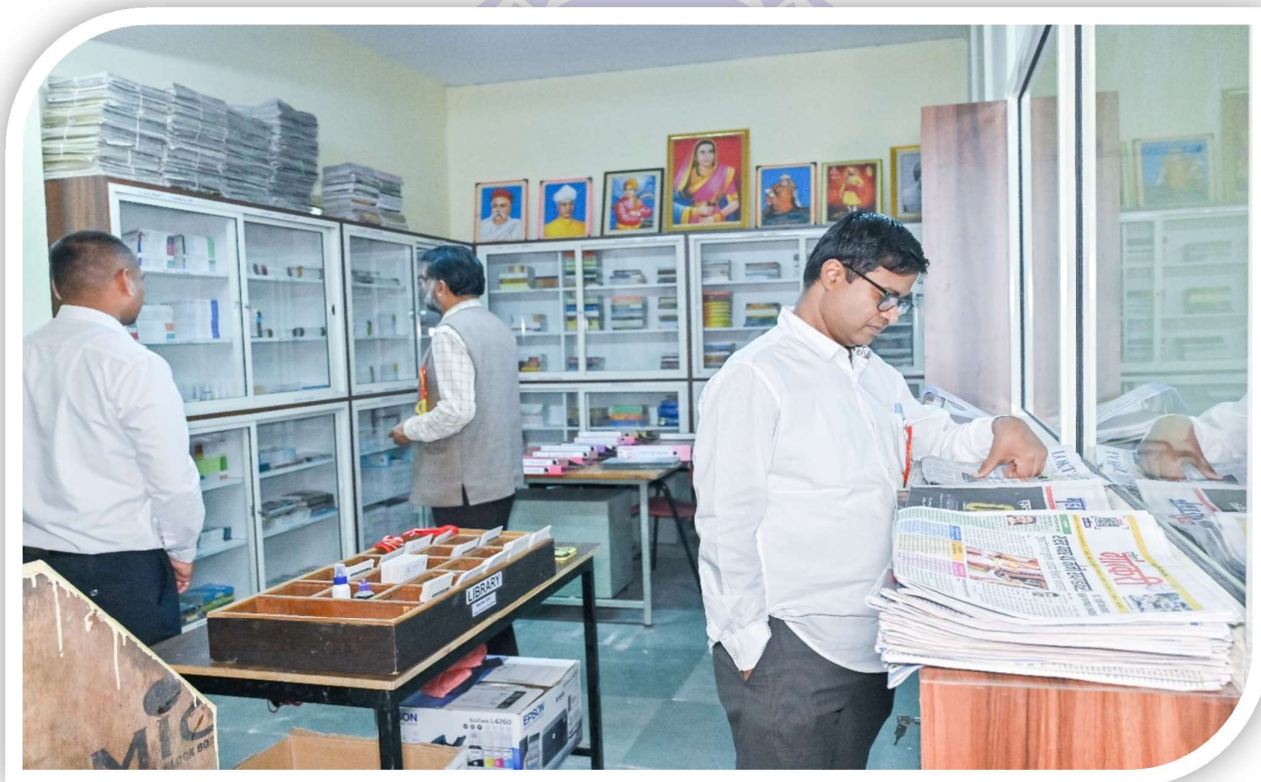

## GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE
